Income and Expense Statement at 19 September 2022:

- Revenue of \$69,882.73 has been recognised year to date.
- The main revenue sources continue to be Tuckshop Income (\$45,587.81) and P&F Subscriptions (\$19,376.00)

Balance Sheet at 19 September 2022:

- Expenses of \$126,651.17 have been recognised year to date.
- The main expense being \$91,988.42 as previously committed donations to the school for the Junior School Playground Equipment; and \$28,800 donation to the School for the P9 Mountain Bikes.
- For the current Financial Year the Net Result being a loss Year-to-Date of \$56,768.44.

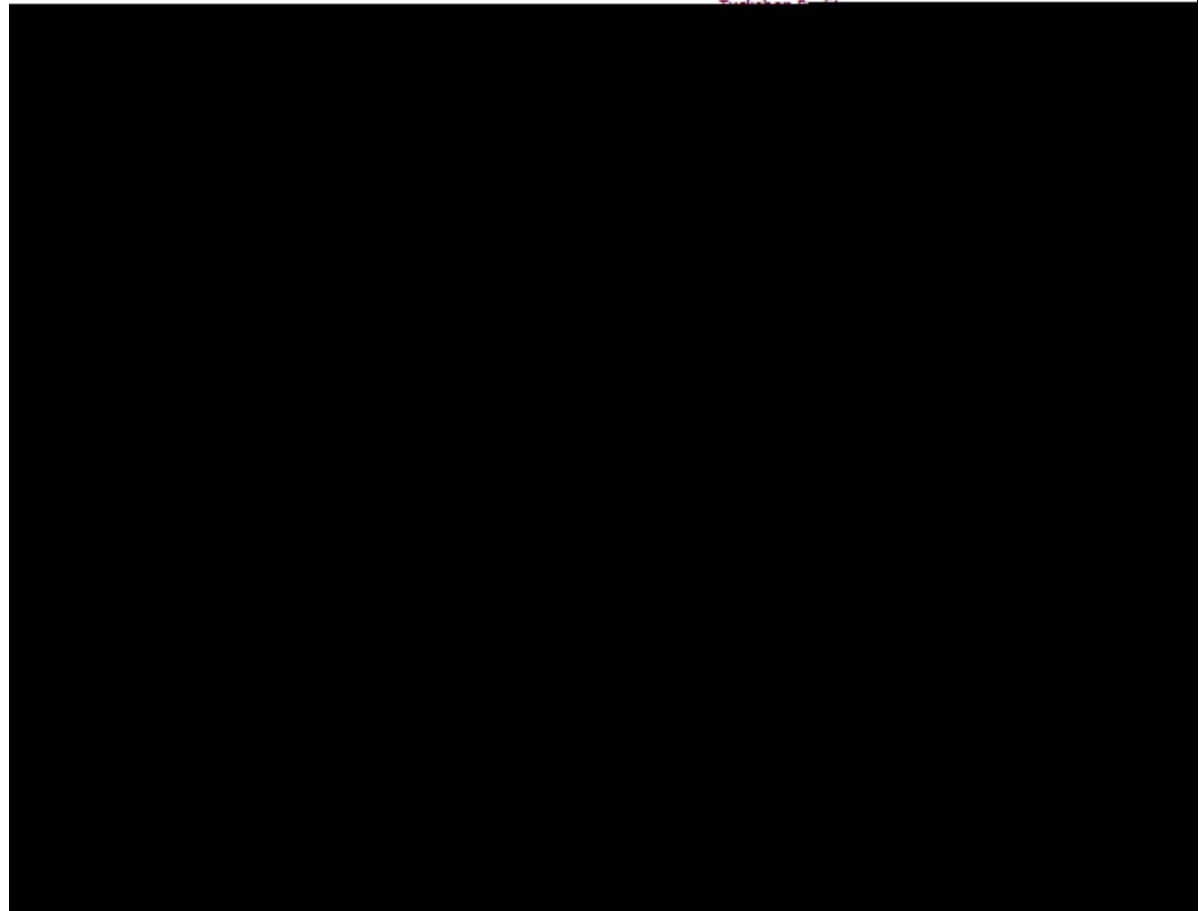
Cash at Bank:
